Re: Range Safety

When using the large range only use club target stands. It is each member's responsibility to ensure all rounds impact the berm behind the 200-yard line. No rounds are to hit the ground due to ricochet hazards. This means no shooting of any targets set on the ground, the 100 yard or 50 yard pad.

On the small range use the target frames at each yardage, so all rounds go into the berms behind each target frame. Do not place targets on the target frames that will impact any place other than the designated target location posted in the small range shooting area.

On the pistol range all rounds shall impact the south berm.
